

Spring 2 in Year 3!

English

This half term the children will be reading a new story called 'Into the Forest'. We will look in detail at the illustrations and use these to answer questions about the text.

Later this half term we will be studying a 'Power of Reading' book to develop our creative writing. We will be learning how to write descriptively and persuasively as well as writing a letter and a poem.

Reminder: Year 3 weekly spelling test will be on a Monday and new spellings will be available on Tuesday on Class Dojo and Spelling Shed.

Maths

Year 3 will be completing a measurement unit learning how to measure and calculate length and perimeter in mm, cm and m.

After this, we will be focusing on fractions. This will start with some revision from Year 2, recognising and finding halves, quarters and thirds. The children will also have a daily arithmetic lesson to help improve number and calculations skills.

Reminder: We will also be practising 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables on Times table Rockstars and Education City.

PE

Children need to attend school on Wednesday in their PE kits. We will be resuming with our 'circuit training' unit and don't forget you can still join in PE with Joe Wicks at 9am on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday on YouTube before we welcome all of you back to school on 8th March.

Music

We will be continuing our trumpet sessions in school on a Monday as well as learning about pulse and rhythm through Oak National Academy.

French

Year 3 will be learning how to introduce and describe themselves in French as well as saying their age and birthday.

World Book Day

We will be celebrating World Book Day on Monday 8th March taking part in a range of activities including designing a potato character, creating a bookmark and taking part in the masked reader quiz.

Science

In Science, this half term Year 3 will be learning about
Light & Dark

We will be finding out how we are able to see objects and the difference between day and night. We will also be investigating reflective materials and find out how shadows are formed.

We will be re-telling the Easter story and looking closely at Jesus' words at the last supper. We will also be looking at the importance of the cross and resurrection to Christians.
