

# Summer 2 in Year 3

## English

This half term Year 3 will be focusing on a new 'Power of Reading' book to inspire our creative writing.



'The Wild Robot' will develop the children's poetry skills as well as writing: a play script, a book review and their own story sequel.

*Reminder: Year 3 weekly spelling test will be on a Monday and new spellings will be available on Class Dojo and Spelling Shed.*

## Maths

Year 3 will be focusing on measurement this half term. We will be recapping **length and perimeter** as well as learning about **time, shape, mass and capacity**.



The children will continue to have a daily arithmetic lesson to help improve their fluency and confidence in number and calculations skills.

*Reminder: We will also be practising the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables on Times table Rockstars and Education City.*

## PE

Children need to attend school on **Wednesday** in their PE kits.

ICT - The children will be using 'i-Control' to learn about algorithms and to understand computer networks and systems.

## Music

Year 3 will be continue their trumpet sessions in school on a **Monday**.



## RE

This half term in RE the children will explore our key question:

**What is it like to follow God?**

## PSHE

Year 3 will be focusing on '**Relationships**' this half term. We will also continue to take part in a mindfulness dance session with Mrs Kilmartin on a Friday pm.

## Science

In Science, this half term Year 3 will be learning about:

**'Light and Dark' & 'Magnets'**

We will be revisiting some of our learning we did over lockdown and conducting our own practical experiments.

## Geography

This half term the children will be learning all about:

**COASTS**

We will be trying to answer our key question '*Do we like to be beside the seaside?*' as well as investigating the physical features of the British coastline and how it has changed over time.
