The first book we are going to learn about this half term is 'Quest' by Aaron Becker. We will be exploring the illustrations and writing descriptions. We will then write our own quest story.

The second book we are reading is called 'Boy 87'. This is a transition unit which lots of children around Bradford are studying. Each child will have their own copy of the book to take home and keep.

Finally, towards the end of the term, we are going to be learning some information about the Titanic.

Maths

- Algebra
- Ratio and proportion

ICT

ICT is taught by Junior Jam. Pupils will plan, create and write a program to run an external device. This will involve writing code, making algorithms, solving and debugging any issues, and coding to achieve the goals set out by the instructor.

Music

The children will be learning about inspirational women in music and gender equality. The children will be composing rap lyrics.

Science

Animals including humans

The children will name main parts of the human circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. They will learn about the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function. Finally, they will discover the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans.

PE

Sports UK will be delivering sessions of PE. Next half term the focus will be athletics/ Olympics.

Children need to be in their kit on Wednesdays.

Year 6 have an extra PE session on a Wednesday afternoon.
