





OUR BRADFORD

Sir Titus Salt - Titus the Tyrant or Salt of the Earth?

In class we will learn about the impact of industrialisation on Bradford and research the history and importance of Salts Mill. The children will discover a typical day in the life of a mill worker.

We will learn about the significance of Sir Titus Salt, his influence on Bradford and his “model village” at Saltaire. We will discuss whether his ideas made him a local hero or a disliked villain!



Sir Titus Salt

We will be exploring the location of Saltaire through Ordnance Survey (OS) maps and how the area has changed over time.

On 13th September 2021 we will have the opportunity to visit Saltaire village. We will be meeting a tour guide at Victoria Hall before embarking on the Saltaire Heritage Trail!

Key Vocabulary

Almshouse: a house founded by charity, offering accommodation for poor people.

Ban: to officially or legally prohibit something.

Business*: a person's regular occupation, profession, or trade.

Century: a period of 100 years.

Condition: the circumstances or factors affecting the way in which people live or work.

Consequence: a result or effect, typically one that is unwelcome or unpleasant.

Construct: build or make (something, typically a building, road, or machine)

Famous*: known about by many people.

Library*: a building or room containing collections of books

Manufacture: to make (something) on a large scale using machinery.

Philanthropist: a person who seeks to promote the welfare of others

Resident: a person who lives somewhere permanently or on a long-term basis.

Respect: due regard for the feelings, wishes, or rights of others.

Village: a group of houses and associated buildings, larger than a hamlet and smaller than a town.
