
To help prepare for the raffle we will be holding a non uniform day on Friday 30 June and would kindly ask that all children bring a donation on this day towards our tombola stall.

Attendance Update

We have started this half term with an overall school attendance of 93.2%. Thank you to all the families in school who are supporting us by ensuring children arrive regularly to school and on time each day.

We continue to have a small number of children arriving late to school on a regular basis, please be reminded school starts at 8:40am every day. Pupils arriving after 9:10am will be marked as present at school however will lose their morning mark which will affect their overall attendance.

Persistent late arrivals at school may be referred to Bradford Council who may issue you with a Penalty Notice in accordance with the Penalty Notice Code of Conduct or take other legal action in relation to poor school attendance.

Free School Meal Uniform Allowance

If your child is currently in receipt of *income based* free school meals you are eligible to apply for 1 embroidered jumper or cardigan, 1 embroidered polo and 1 family hoodie free of charge from school this academic year.

If you would like to order these items ready for September 2022 complete the jotform shared via ClassDojo by Monday 05 June 2023.

If you do not currently receive income based free school meals, but feel you may qualify, please apply online at: https://www.bradford.gov.uk/benefits/applying-for-benefits/free-school-meals/. Once we receive confirmation of your eligibility we can then order your free uniform.

You can apply for income based free school meals if you receive:

- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16,190, provided they are not receiving Working Tax
 Credit
- the 'Guaranteed' element of the State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income threshold of less than £7,400
