Class Haworth Visit to Jorvik

On Tuesday 2nd July 2024, Class Haworth will be going on a trip to Jorvik, York.

The Jorvik trip links closely with the history that has been taught in Class Haworth this year. The children will be able to immerse themselves into the life of a Viking. They will take a journey through the reconstruction of Viking Age streets and experience life as it would have been in 10th century York. During the trip, Class Haworth will also learn how to be archaeologists, by becoming trainee 'diggers' and discovering the most exciting artefacts from 2000 years of history!

The children and staff will travel by coach, departing at 9.00am and returning to school in time to be collected at 3.15pm.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink from home. If your child is entitled to free school meals, they will be provided with a packed lunch from school. In addition, children should wear their school uniform and bring a waterproof coat.

The contribution for this visit is £25.00 and can be paid via ParentPay. Parental consent should be given and payments made on ParentPay by **Tuesday 25th June 2024.**
