Class Keighley Visit to Industrial Museum

On Tuesday 18th June 2024, Class Keighley will be going on a trip to The Industrial Museum.

Class Keighley have been learning about how the local area has changed over time, with a focus on the change in transport. At the Bradford Industrial Museum, the children will go on their own transport journey through the museum using maps and role play whilst looking at the amazing transport collection. They will develop noticing and drawing skills and record information about different modes of transport, including a full-size train and a range of vehicles made in Bradford by the Jowett family. Before coming back to school, the children will be able to visit the tram shed and see one of Bradford's last trams, just like the ones that used to come to Wibsey!

The children and staff will travel by coach, departing at 9.00am and returning to school at 3:15pm.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink from home. If your child is entitled to free school meals, they will be provided with a packed lunch from school. In addition, children should wear their school uniform and bring a waterproof coat.

The contribution for this visit is £13.00 and can be paid via ParentPay. Parental consent should be given and payments made on ParentPay by **Tuesday 11**th **June 2024.**
