Dear Parent/Carer,

I'm writing to share our 'alternative' plans regarding Christmas performances this year. It's a great thing to see your child participating in festive events with their class mates and we know that these opportunities are an important part of a child's education. With this in mind, we plan to share our class festive treats via a YouTube private link which will be sent to parents during w/c 14 December 2020.

In order to respect the privacy of all our families, and to safeguard our pupils, we ask that families support us by agreeing that:

- ***Images and videos must be for your own or family's personal use only***
- ***You will consider who has the right to view/ listen to the recordings; not only for your own child, but for the protection of others as well***
- ***You will consider whether or not to share imagery online. If you choose to do so then you must make sure this is limited to images/footage of your own child/children, shared with immediate family only and not made publicly available on any social media platforms or websites without explicit consent to do so***

These guidelines are the same as if pupils were performing live and parents recorded parts of the singing, as usually happens at this type of occasion.

If you would prefer your child **not to be included** in the YouTube recordings please inform school by Monday 30 November.

Please be aware that if we do not hear from yourself, regarding the removal of previously obtained consent, then your child **will be involved** with the class recording.
