Personal Development

Our distinctive Church school ethos

Children will take part in daily collective worship, We will spend time together as a school, in a class and as part of our 'Value Families.'

PSHE: In our PSHE lessons, we will be teaching RSE, the school uses the Chris Winter project, which was chosen following consultation with parents, Further information can be found on the school website.

My Happy Mind: In our My Happy Mind sessions we will be exploring friendships and looking at strategies that will support us during the transition period between primary and secondary school.

P.E: Our specialist PE coach will continue to teach our PE sessions in Year 6 focusing on cricket and athletics skills.

Our World

Religious Education:

Children will learn about what a pilgrimage is for both secular and religious people. They will then focus on the six main world religions and identify the role of pilgrimage in each religion. This will include finding out about specific pilgrimages (such as the Hajj) and when and where the pilgrimages take place.

Geography:

In geography, we will be planning and carrying out a fieldwork enquiry. Students will learn how to collect data in a variety of ways. Children will apply the skills learned over the topic to conduct their own enquiry.

STEM

Science:

In science, we will be learning about electricity, through planning and conducting investigations to determine how the voltage in a circuit affects the brightness of a bulb. In addition, we will use our 'working scientifically' skills to plan an experiment to investigate variations in how components function and use the results to write a clear and scientific

Maths:

In our mathe lessons, we will be completing a project to

Speaking and listening: During our learning, speaking will be encouraged through role play, debates and sharing ideas and our work with the class. We will also be working on our end of year performances, working together and practicing performing to an audience.

Reading: In our reading lessons, we will be reading 'The Final Year' by Matt Goodfellow. We will read the text and develop a deeper understanding of the characters, their thoughts and emotions. We will discuss the authors choice of vocabulary and the impact on the reader.



Writing: We will be writing a range of text types to consolidate and apply our learning. As part of our immersion, we will have a story writing workshop to help us gather ideas. We will also write short setting descriptions and a recipe linked to our learning in DT.

This half term we will have an increased focus on the editing process and evaluation of our writing.

Spelling: In our spelling sessions, we will continue to look at the statutory Year 6 spellings and continue to apply them within our writing.

French: In our French lessons, we will continue to consolidate all the vocabulary we have leant over Key Stage 2.
